

COVID SAFE TICKET

Waregem Koerse 2021 is a mass event and opts to use the **Covid Safe Ticket (CST)**. The CST is available to residents of the European Union, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

All visitors (from birth year 2009) must meet the conditions of the Covid Safe Ticket and must be in possession of:

- ❖ Either a recognised **vaccination certificate**, attesting to a complete vaccination, dated **two weeks** (= before 17/08/21);
- ❖ Either a **negative PCR test**. Validity: day of the test plus a maximum of **48h**;
- ❖ Either a **certificate of recovery**. Validity: **10 days** from the date of the first positive PCR test up to a maximum of **180 days** from the date of that first positive test.
- ❖ Either a **negative rapid antigen test**, administered by medically trained personnel. Validity: day of test **plus 1 day**.

This personal certificate must be presented digitally (via the [CovidSafeBE](#) app for Belgian residents or the Digital Covid Certificate of your country) or on paper upon arrival at the VIP parking or the hippodrome. Not being in possession of a valid certificate will irrevocably lead to denial of access.

For Belgian residents: The CST certificate can be requested digitally via the [CovidSafeBE](#) app (mobile app available for iOS and Android: make sure you have the most recent version of the app) and on websites such as [MyHealthViewer](#). To request digital certificates, you need either your identity card, PIN code and card reader, or another activated digital key (for example itsme). With the most recent version of the CovidSafeBE app you can test yourself whether your certificates/tests are sufficient to gain access to Waregem Koerse.

IMPORTANT: download/install/print the certificate before leaving for Waregem Koerse! Make sure you are in possession of **proof of identity** on arrival to be able to check your certificate. Waregem Koerse **does not offer** the possibility to take a rapid antigen test on site.

⇒ children under the age of 12 must not be in possession of a CST, but must be able to prove their age (KIDS-ID)

Visitors in possession of a valid CST must in the outdoor area of Waregem Koerse:

- ❖ Not wear a mouth ask
- ❖ Not respect the social distance

⇒ In the indoor area of Waregem Koerse, the catering protocol applies and visitors have to:

- ❖ Wear a mouth mask during movements
- ❖ Consume while seated at your own table
